Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for her consent to the making, under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, of an Order the effect of which will be that the undermentioned length of road shall become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.:

New Street, Ash, in the Rural District of Eastry, from the existing termination of the speed limit at its junction with Langdon Avenue south-eastwards to a point 25 yards south of its junction with Orchard View (length 215 yards).

The County Council of Kent (Weeks Lane, Brabourne) (Width Restriction) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load, exceeds six feet six inches to proceed along Weeks Lane, Brabourne, between its junction with Pilgrims Way and the un-named road leading to West Brabourne (length approximately 1 mile).

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable any vehicle to be used on the road concerned for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from premises situated there, or in connection with agriculture, timber haulage, any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The County Council of Kent (Crispe Road, Acol, Monkton and Margate) (Width Restriction) Order

Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for her consent to the making, under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, of an Order the effect of which will be that the undermentioned lengths of road at Langton Green, Speldhurst, shall become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.:

- (a) Dornden Drive, Langton Road, A.264, north-westwards to Farnham Lane, including the cul-de-sac which extends from a point 60 yards east of Asher Reeds for approximately 90 yards south-eastwards;
- (b) Farnham Lane, from Langton Road, A.264, to 10 yards north of Dornden Drive;
- (c) Newlands, from Langton Road, A.264, to Dornden Drive;
- (d) Longmeads, from Dornden Drive to the boundary of the Royal Borough of Tunbridge Wells;
