HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Hampshire (Ringwood and Fordingbridge Rural District No. 9) (Parish of Ringwood Part of Footpath No. 35) Public Path Diversion Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 30th day of November 1966 the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect will be to divert the public footpath right of way in the Parish of Ringwood from the route described in "A" of the Schedule hereto to the route described in "B" thereof.

The path referred to in the Order is Footpath No. 35 in the Parish of Ringwood as shown on the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way prepared under the provisions of Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Ringwood and Fordingbridge Rural District Council Offices.

The Order becomes operative as from the day of publication of this notice, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

A footpath of undefined width commencing at the northern end of Woodend Road running in a north-easterly direction across O.S. Parcel No. 434 and thence in a northerly direction across O.S. Parcels Nos. 435 and 437 to the bridge crossing the stream which runs along the northern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 437. A total distance of 220 yards.

A footpath 4 feet wide commencing at the northern end of Woodend Road to the west of the existing path running in a northerly direction across O.S. Parcel No. 434 and thence in a north-easterly direction across O.S. Parcels Nos. 435 and 437 to the bridge crossing the stream which runs along the northern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 437. A total distance of 220 yards.

The Glamorgan County Council (Heol-y-Deri, Rhiwbina Hill and Wenallt Road, Rhiwbina) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that on the 9th day of December 1966, the County Council made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit, subject to certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles from 6 p.m. to 12 midnight, for seven days per week on:

- (i) the northern side of those sections of Rhiwbina Hill and Wenallt Road, Rhiwbina, from the north-western boundary of the premises known as No. 4 Rhiwbina Hill to the bridge over Nant Cwmno-fydd in Wenallt Road, a distance of approximately 220 yards;

- (ii) the eastern side of those sections of Wenallt Road and Heol-y-Deri, Rhiwbina, from the bridge over Nant Cwmno-fydd in Wenallt Road to the north-west side of the junction of Heol-y-Deri with Heol-y-Llanishen-fach, a distance of approximately 344 yards;

- (iii) the western side of that section of Heol-y-Deri, Rhiwbina, from the north-west side of its junction with Lon-y-Winci to the south-eastern side of its junction with Heol Brynglas, a distance of approximately 130 yards.
