MINES AND QUARRIES ACT 1954*Draft Coal Mines (Training) Regulations 1967*

The Minister of Power, in accordance with the provisions of section 142 of, and Part I of the Second Schedule to, the Mines and Quarries Act 1954, hereby gives notice that he proposes to make General Regulations under sections 124 (2), 141 and 143 of the Act, entitled the Coal Mines (Training) Regulations 1967.

These regulations will replace, with amendments, the Coal Mines (Training) Regulations 1956, the Coal Mines (Training) (Variation) Regulations 1957 and the Coal Mines (Training) (Variation) Regulations 1960; they will apply to all coal mines.

The chief change in the proposed new regulations is that preliminary training on first employment below ground, and training for work in coal production shall be governed by training schemes which, except in the case of preliminary training of adults, must be approved by the Minister. The regulations do not prescribe the detail of training to be given, which is the case in the existing regulations, but instead lay down certain basic requirements with which the training schemes will have to comply. Since the existing regulations were made many changes have occurred in the coal industry and progress made in organised training is such that much of the detail in the existing regulations is no longer appropriate. Moreover, the new draft regulations will allow sufficient flexibility within the basic requirements to provide for new developments in the industry.

- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
