The Borough of Farnworth Devon Street and Fern Street Public Path Diversion Order, 1966

Highways Act, 1959

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 20th day of December 1966 is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way between Devon Street and Fern Street from the present position starting opposite No. 80 Devon Street to a new position starting at a point between the All Saints Church and the All Saints School in Devon Street and proceeding north-east to a point at the rear of the Church and then proceeding south-east for a distance of 335 yards on the boundary of the new road known as the Farnworth and Kearsley By-Pass. The situation of the path and the proposed diversion is set out fully in the Map attached to the Order.
