PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 REFERENCE TO THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

Pay and Conditions of Limb-Fitters employed by J. E. Hanger and Company

1. J. E. Hanger and Company are the largest of a small number of manufacturers of artificial limbs under contract to the Ministry of Health, employing limb-fitters at various centres throughout the country.

2. On 5th December 1966, following some months of negotiations between the Company and the Association of Supervisory Staffs, Executives and Technicians (ASSET), the Company agreed to pay its limb-fitters a salary increase of £100 a year from 2nd January 1967, subject to further discussions on improving efficiency and on a revaluation of limb-fitters' duties.

3. This case is important in regard to the application of the criteria for prices and incomes during the period of severe restraint and from the point of view of the health and welfare of disabled persons.

4.
