

Brighton

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes to make an Order under section 153 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of Paradise Street and lengths of Mount Street, Lavender Street and Essex Street, an unnamed footpath at Essex Street, and another part of Lavender Street, Brighton in order to enable residential development to be carried out by Brighton C.B.C. in accordance with Planning permission granted under Part III of the Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of two new highways and of four new footpaths maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Brighton C.B.C.

Exeter

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes to make an Order under section 153 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of lengths of two footpaths off Clapperbrook Lane, Exeter to enable development of a trading estate to be carried out by Exeter C.C. in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Act.
