GRANTHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Grantham (No. 12) Smoke Control Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Grantham Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on 30th December 1966 made an Order entitled the Borough of Grantham (No. 12) Smoke Control Order 1966, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order has been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at my office, Guildhall, Grantham, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from 13th January 1967.

The Order will come into operation on 1st June 1968.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SALFORD CITY COUNCIL

The City of Salford (Higher Broughton) Smoke Control Order No. 12, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and citizens of the City of Salford, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 7th day of December 1966, made an Order entitled "The City of Salford (Higher Broughton) Smoke Control Order No. 12, 1966", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1967, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Salford, 3, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 20th day of January 1967.

Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
