**STAINES URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL***The Staines (No. 8) Smoke Control Order, 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Staines in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 15th day of December 1966, made an Order entitled the Staines (No. 8) Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of June 1968, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Council at "Elmsleigh", 73 High Street, Staines, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 20th day of January 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

All that part of the district bounded as follows:  
North. The northern boundary of the Urban District from its junction with the boundary of Area No. 7 eastwards to the boundary of the London Borough of Hounslow.

East. The boundary of the Urban District from its junction with the boundary of the London Borough of Hounslow to the boundary of the Urban District of Sunbury-on-Thames.

South. The boundary of the Urban District from its junction on the east with the Urban District of Sunbury-on-Thames to the boundary of Area No. 7.

West. The eastern boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 7 from its junction with the northern boundary of the Urban District to its junction with the southern boundary of the Urban District.
