

BLACKBURN COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough of Blackburn (Central Area No. 5) (No Waiting) Order 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the Blackburn County Borough Council propose to make an Order under Section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be to place various restrictions on parking in the streets specified in the Schedule. The usual exemptions in favour of loading and unloading, picking up and setting down passengers, statutory undertakings, building operations, invalid carriages, etc., and funerals will apply.

Three types of restrictions are proposed:—

A—Waiting prohibited between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on all days except Sundays.

B—Waiting restricted to one hour in any period of two hours between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on all days except Sundays.

C—Waiting prohibited at all times.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 6th day of February 1967.
