NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE CITY AND COUNTY COUNCIL

The City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne Monument/Market Street Experimental Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be:

- (a) To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto, otherwise than in the direction stated.
- (b) To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle other than a public service vehicle on the length of road specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto.
- (c) to prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles in any of the lengths of road specified in Part III of the Schedule hereto between the hours of 8 to 9.15 a.m. and 4 to 6 p.m., on any day other than Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday, New Year's Day or a Bank Holiday.
- (d) To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle so as to make the right-hand turn specified in Part IV of the Schedule hereto.
- (e) To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle so as to make the left-hand turn specified in Part V of the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, and the collection and delivery of postal packages.

The Order shall remain in force for a period of three months, unless on the application of the Local Authority the Minister otherwise directs.

A draft of the proposed Order and a plan showing the Council's proposals may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and objections may be sent, in writing, to the undersigned, by not later than 3rd February 1967.
