##### *Direction under Article 4*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government has approved a Direction dated the 23rd day of November 1966, made by the Devon County Council as Local Planning Authority under Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order, the effect of which is to prohibit the use of an area of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) within the Barnstaple Rural and Ilfracombe Urban Districts for any purpose except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of movable structures on the land for the purpose of that use permitted by Article 3 and the First Schedule (Class IV.2) and the above-mentioned Order, unless planning permission therefor is granted on application made in that behalf.

##### *Hampshire Development Plan Winchester Town Map*

Notice is hereby given that on the 21st day of December 1966, the Minister of Housing and Local Government amended the above Development Plan by substituting a new Town Map for Winchester in place of the Town Map previously approved in 1955 and which is now cancelled. The amendment relates to an area of and comprising almost the whole of the City of Winchester, the whole of the Parish of Abbots Barton, almost the whole of the Parish of Oliver's Battery, and small parts of the Parishes of Chilcomb, Compton, Headbourne Worthy, Hursley, Itchen Valley, Littleton, Sparsholt and Twyford in the Rural District of Winchester.

A copy of the report of the Minister's Inspector relating to the public local inquiry held on the 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 14th February 1963, into objections to the Local Planning Authority's proposals for the amendment of the Development Plan, and a copy of a statement of the Minister's reasons for departing from certain of the Inspector's recommendations, have also been deposited at the above mentioned offices.

The copy or extract of the Development Plan and the report and statement so deposited will be open for inspection, free of charge, to all persons interested during normal office hours from Mondays to Fridays.

The amendment became operative as from the 7th day of January 1967, but, if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the 7th day of January 1967, make application to the High Court.
