Royal County of Berkshire (Sunninghill, Blacknest Gate Road) (No Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council hereby give notice of their proposal to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which shall be to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time during the whole 24-hour period on Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays, and Good Friday on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exceptions are included in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation, or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by not later than 10th day of February 1967.

That length of Blacknest Gate Road, which extends from its junction with the Virginia Water-Ascot Road (A.329) in a northerly direction for a distance of 180 yards.

Royal County of Berkshire (Bracknell) (Experimental No Waiting) Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th day of July 1966, the Berkshire County Council made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive during the period of three months from the date on which this Order comes into operation in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions have been included in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of January 1967.

(a) Western Road from its junction with the Bracknell/Wokingham Road (A.329) to its junction with Downshire Way.

(b) Easthampstead Road from its junction with the roundabout under the railway in a northerly direction to its northerly termination.

(d) Down Mill Road for its entire length.

*In the Parish of Bracknell**High Street*

(i) (North Side)

from a point opposite the western side of the junction of High Street with Skimped Hill in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 100 yards.

(ii) (South Side)

(a) from the eastern point of the south side of High Street, which is the subject of the "Bracknell, High Street (No Waiting) Order, 1964", situated approximately 15 yards east of the junction with Station Road, in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 35 yards.

(b) from the western point of the south side of High Street which is the subject of the "Bracknell, High Street" (No Waiting) Order, 1964, in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 150 yards.

Skimped Hill (Both Sides) from its junction with High Street to a point 42 yards west of its junction with Market Street, a distance of approximately 75 yards.

Market Street (Both Sides) from its junction with Skimped Hill to the entrance to the 'Bus garage for a distance of approximately 15 yards.
