*The City of Cardiff (Bute Street and West Bute Street) (Street Parking Places) Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the Cardiff City Council propose to make an Order under section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and subsection (2) of section 11 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which will be (a) to authorise the use as parking places of the lengths of road referred to in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for such classes of vehicles, in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in the said Schedule and (b) to revoke the Cardiff (Parking Places) No. 5 Order, 1934, as amended, insofar as it authorises the use, as parking places, of parts of the carriageway on the west side of West Bute Street.

## CARDIFF CITY COUNCIL

*The City and County Borough of Cardiff (West Bute Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the Cardiff City Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (a) at all times in the length of road specified in the First Schedule hereto or (b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in either of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading or unloading, and for funerals, building and road works and the maintenance of essential services.

## GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Glamorgan (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) Order, 1967*
