WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Retail Draper, Outfitting and Footwear Trades Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Retail Drapery, Outfitting and Footwear Trades Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Retail
