LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON

*The London Borough of Croydon (No. 9)
Smoke Control Order, 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the London Borough of Croydon in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 19th day of December 1966, made an Order entitled "The London Borough of Croydon (No. 9) Smoke Control Order, 1966", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st July 1968, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Katherine Street, Croydon, and at the office of the Chief Public Health Inspector, 47 Wellesley Road, Croydon, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 27th January 1967.
