SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (Various Streets at Minehead) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restricted Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Somerset propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

(1) To prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day, other than a Sunday, in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.

(2) The existing restrictions on waiting by vehicles in the lengths of the Esplanade and Warren Road specified in the Second Schedule hereto which operate between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. from the 1st April to the 30th September each year shall in future operate between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight or to load or unload goods from the vehicle or to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
