A. Prohibition of Waiting.—To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road-

- (a) The north side, between its junction with the east side of Victory Road and its junction with the west side of St. George's Square.
- (b) The south side, between its junction with the west side of St. George's Square and a point 22 feet west of that junction.
- (c) The south side, between a point 50 feet west of its junction with the west side of St. George's Square and a point 85 feet west of that junction.
- B. Prohibition of Waiting for longer than one hour. To prohibit waiting by vehicles for a longer period than one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on week-days on the following lengths of road—

- Ordnance Row
 (a) The south side, between a point 22 feet west of its junction with the west side of St. George's Square and a point 50 feet west of that junction.
 - (b) The south side, between a point 85 feet west of its junction with the west side of St. George's Square and its junction with the north side of St. George's Road.
- C. One Way Traffic.—To prohibit the driving of any vehicle along the under-mentioned length of road otherwise than in the direction stated-
