ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Ashton-under-Lyne (Market Square No. 2) (Amendment) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th day of May 1967, the Ashton-under-Lyne Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting on the north side of Market Place.

The Order contains an exemption in favour of vehicles from which people are alighting or on to which they are boarding and in favour of vehicles required for carrying out road works or building operations.

ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Ashton-under-Lyne (Newmarket Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th day of May 1967, the Ashton-under-Lyne Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting on both sides of Newmarket Road between Downing Street and Earnshaw Street.

The Order provides for exemptions in respect of vehicles parked for the loading or unloading of people or goods, vehicles involved with work in the road or in building or demolition operations adjacent to the road and vehicles waiting to take in petrol, oil, water or air.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Fore Street, Yealmpton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1967.

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th May 1967, the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is:

(a) to prohibit waiting by vehicles between 9 a.m.—7 p.m. daily in the following lengths of road

Fore Street (A.379), Yealmpton

both sides, from a point 76 yards west of its junction with Yealmbury Hill in a westerly direction for a distance of 63 yards;

north side, from its junction with Yealmbury Hill in a westerly direction for a distance of 35 yards;

(b) to limit waiting to periods of 30 minutes between 9 a.m.—7 p.m. daily in the following length of road—

Fore Street (A.379), Yealmpton

north side, from a point 35 yards west of its junction with Yealmbury Hill in a westerly direction for a distance of 41 yards.

Exceptions are provided in the Order for boarding or alighting from vehicles; loading or unloading goods; for building operations, road maintenance and repairs or other similar works; and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage.
