ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Polperro) (Experimental Road Restriction) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that, at the direction of the Minister of Transport, a public inquiry will be held by A. Tildesley, Esq., at the British Legion Hall, Polperro, on Thursday, 8th June 1967, at 10 a.m., to consider the proposal of the Cornwall County Council to make an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be (i) to prohibit any person from causing any motor vehicle, other than an excepted vehicle, to proceed on any of the lengths of road specified in the schedule hereto during the period 1st July-30th September 1967 (both dates inclusive) and (ii) to suspend, during the period of operation of the Experimental Order, the County of Cornwall (The Warren, Polperro) (Road Restriction) Order, 1960 (by which the driving of any vehicle other than a handcart, perambulator, invalid carriage or pedal cycle pushed by hand on The Warren, Polperro, is prohibited).

For the purpose of the Order an "excepted vehicle" means either a public service vehicle, an invalid carriage, a specially adapted motor vehicle exempt from road fund duty under section 11 of the Finance Act, 1964, or a vehicle the driver of which has on account of his severe physical disability been issued with a badge by any county council or by any county borough council in pursuance of a scheme made under section 29 of the National Assistance Act, 1948.

The Order will also contain exceptions to enable vehicles to be used:

(a) for the conveyance of either persons, being resident in or temporarily resident in premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads, or bona fide invitees of such persons, or persons engaged in any profession, occupation, trade or service during the course of their work, or

persons requiring access to or returning from such premises in connection with medical treatment or attending school or bona fide meetings of any religious, political, local government cultural or social organisation, or in connection with a funeral;

- (b) for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads;
- (c) for police, fire brigade, or ambulance purposes;
- (d) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to any of those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in any of those roads, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of those roads, of the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to any of those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878; or
- (e) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or traffic warden in uniform.

Any person interested is entitled to be heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent and any person whether he intends to appear at the Inquiry or not may forward any objections to the proposal to A. Tildesley, Esq., at the undermentioned address.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road at Polperro in the Parish of Lansallos

(i) Looe—Polperro Road (A.387) comprising The Coombes and part of Fore Street, Polperro, from its junction with the Polperro—Langreek Road (Class III) to its termination at its junction with the Link Road which crosses the Saxon Bridge to the junction of Lansallos Street (Unclassified) with Landaviddy Lane (Unclassified), a distance of 705 yards or thereabouts.

(ii) Part of Fore Street (Unclassified) from its junction with the A.387 to its junction with Talland Hill (Unclassified), a distance of 40 yards or thereabouts.

(iii) Polperro—Talland Road (Unclassified), known as Talland Hill, from its junction with Fore Street (Unclassified) to its junction with Brent Fields Road (Unclassified) a distance of 604 yards or thereabouts.

(iv) Polperro—Landaviddy Road (Unclassified), known as Landaviddy Lane, from its junction with Lansallos Street (Unclassified) to the entrance to Little Landaviddy, a distance of 761 yards or thereabouts.

(v) Lansallos Street (Unclassified) from its junction with Landaviddy Lane to its junction with Fish Quay (Unclassified) a distance of 97 yards or thereabouts.

(vi) Fish Quay (Unclassified) from its junction with Lansallos Street to its termination at The Pier, a distance of 99 yards or thereabouts.

(vii) The Unclassified Link Road known in part as Big Green, which crosses the Saxon Bridge between Fore Street (A.387) and (Unclassified) and the junction of Lansallos Street (Unclassified) with Landaviddy Lane (Unclassified).

(viii) The Unclassified Link Road, known as Bridge End, which crosses the Roman Bridge between the junction of Talland Street (Unclassified) and The Warren (Unclassified) and the junction of Lansallos Street (Unclassified) and Fish Quay (Unclassified).

(ix) Talland Street (Unclassified) between its junction with Fore Street (Unclassified) and its junction with The Warren (Unclassified).

(x) The Unclassified Link Road known as Little Green between the junction of Talland Street (Unclassified) and Talland Hill (Unclassified) and its junction with the Unclassified Link Road known in part as Big Green.

(xi) The Unclassified Link Road known as Mill Hill and Mill Lane between its junction with Landaviddy Hill and its junction with the A.387.

(xii) The Warren (Unclassified) from its junction with Bridge End (Unclassified) for a distance of 330 yards in an easterly direction.

(xiii) The Warren (Unadopted) from a point 330 yards east of the junction with Bridge End (Unclassified) for a distance of 250 yards.
