DRAFT SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Factories Act 1961

In pursuance of section 180 of, and the Fourth Schedule to the Factories Act 1961, the Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he proposes to make special regulations imposing requirements as to guards and protection flanges for abrasive wheels, for the control of the speeds of such wheels and in relation to rests for workpieces at such wheels.

The Regulations also prohibit the sale or letting on hire for use in a factory of certain abrasive wheels which are not marked with their maximum permissible speeds and of certain machines on which abrasive wheels are or are intended to be mounted to which the notice as to working speeds is not affixed as required by the Regulations.

As respects abrasive wheels, these Regulations are in substitution for section 14(1) of the Factories Act 1961, for Regulation 67(2) of the Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing Regulations 1960 and for Regulation 42 of the Construction (General Provisions) Regulations 1961 (all of which require that dangerous parts of machinery shall be securely fenced).

Copies of the draft regulations which are entitled "The Abrasive Wheels Regulations 1967" may be obtained from Her Majesty's Stationery Office at the addresses shown on the last page of this Gazette or through any bookseller.

Any objection to the draft regulations by or on behalf of persons affected must be sent to the Minister on or before 2nd October 1967.

Every objection must be in writing and state—

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
