## NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

### NATIONAL PARKS COMMISSION

#### *Kent Downs Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Designation) Order, 196*

Notice is hereby given that the National Parks Commission propose to make and submit to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation the above Order.

2. The effect of the proposed Order, which will not come into operation until confirmed by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will be to constitute the land to which the proposed Order relates areas of outstanding natural beauty for the purposes of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949.

3. The proposed Order relates to land situated in the County of Kent, and in Greater London, and comprises land within the undermentioned districts:—

The City of Rochester;  
The Municipal Boroughs of Dover, Folkestone, Gillingham, Hythe and Maidstone;  
The London Borough of Bromley;  
The Urban District of Sevenoaks;  
The Rural Districts of Bridge-Blean, Dartford, Dover, East Ashford, Elham, Hollingbourn, Malling, Sevenoaks, Strood, Swale, Tonbridge, and West Ashford.

4. A copy of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein has been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Council of each of the areas mentioned above, and will be open for inspection free of charge during office hours. Copies may also be inspected at the offices of the National Parks Commission, 1 Cambridge Gate, Regents Park, London N.W.1.

5. Any representations with reference to the proposed Order should be sent in writing to the Secretary, National Parks Commission, 1 Cambridge Gate, Regents Park, London N.W.1, so as to arrive not later than the 9th day of September 1967 and any such representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
