To be an additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order, for Gallantry:

Lieutenant Brian Anselm Robert HARRINGTON-SPIER (470081), 3rd (16th/44th Foot) Battalion, The Royal Anglian Regiment.

As the result of freak floods, five days general strike and intensified terrorist activity, the streets in the native town of Sheikh Othman were littered with rubbish and debris. The terrorists were using the rubbish as cover for mines and on 4th April 1967, a Saladin armoured car was blown up on an anti-tank mine hidden in the rubbish. One of the tasks of 3rd Royal Anglian was to ensure free access through the streets of Sheikh Othman for wheeled armoured and soft skinned vehicles.

On the morning of 6th April 1967, Lieutenant Harrington-Spier and his platoon were ordered to clear the roads of mines in a part of Sheikh Othman. This was a tricky operation as it was known that

This was a tricky operation as it was known that enemy snipers and grenadiers were active in the area. The task was carried out by half platoons moving up parallel streets, Lieutenant Harrington-Spier directly commanding one half and his platoon sergeant the other.

After a period of sporadic firing three grenades were thrown at Lieutemant Harrington-Spier's half of the platoon. The grenadiers were supported by automatic fire from seven terrorist roof top positions. In the finital encounter one soldier was slightly In the initial encounter one soldier was slightly wounded and one terrorist grenadier was shot but managed to make good his escape into a mosque. Lieutenant Harrington-Spier, finding his small force pinned down by heavy enemy fire, ordered his platoon sergeant to outflank the enemy positions with the other half of his platoon, but they too were soon pinned down by automatic fire. At this stage a half troop of armoured cars was ordered forward to help extricate the platoon. Lieutenant Harrington-Spier first organised the

Lieutenant Harrington-Spier first organised the withdrawal of his platoon sergeant's force. He indicated enemy positions to the armoured cars and engaged them himself from several positions to cover the withdrawal of his men. He then led the armoured cars to his own party and supervised their withdrawal, he himself remaining behind to the last to cover his men out of the ambush area. During these tricky operations he was under automatic fire and was also the target of a further remode attack grenade attack.

Throughout this action Lieutenant Harrington-Throughout this action Lieutenant Hartungton-Spier moved about his platoon with complete dispersard for his own safety and his inspired leadership, personal courage and tactical good sense extricated his platoon from a carefully laid terrorist ambush with only one slight casualty. Such was the morale of his platoon and his own exuberant determination that his platoon was quickly recommitted to the area. mitted to the area.

23945669 Corporal John Michael VALENTINE, 3rd (16th/44th Foot) Battalion, The Royal Anglian Regiment.

Corporal Valentine was point section commander of 15 Platoon, D Company, 3rd (16th/44th Foot) Battalion, The Royal Anglian Regiment, when his plattoon entered Sheikh Othman on a street clearing operation on the morning of 6th April 1967.

After patrolling for twenty-minutes, his section was suddenly subjected to a simultaneous grenade and automatic fire attack. As the grenade exploded, causing one minor casualty. Corporal Valentine say

and automatic fire attack. As the grenade exploded, causing one minor casualty, Corporal Valentine saw the grenadier and, with another soldier, opened fire at the fleeing target. The grenadier was wounded but managed to reach the safety of a nearby mosque. The tenrorist fire positions on the rooftops were neutralised and Corporal Valentine continued his advance. However, within a few minutes his section again came under heavy automatic fire and rifle

sniping from five separate positions. This fire halted his advance and pinned down half his section. Using fire and movement, he extracted his men from their vulnerable positions and skilfully re-sited them so that the terrorists could be engaged with maximum

When ordered to withdraw to a firm base he issued his orders coolly but with determination. the last man out of every intermediate position and

gave covering fire as his section withdrew.

Throughout these actions, which together lasted for some fifty minutes, Corporal Valentine remained in complete comtrol of his section. He moved about this men giving them encouragement and, by setting a fine example under almost continuous fire, he ensured that the withdrawal to a firm base was carned out in good order and with no further casualties.

Major Emery was in Command of a Beach Survey Team between Ras Momi and Fahr making a passage in two Gemini boats, one of the boats broached on a wave crest and one of its occupants Corporal Palmer, was flung into the sea, and badly injured by the Gemini's propeller. Major Emery recovered the injured man, administered morphine and put in to land at Mutayaf. He decided that the seriousness of Corporal Palmer's wounds necessitated immediate medical attention, some 3 days

necessitated immediate medical attention, some 3 days travel by land away at base camp.

To save time he decided to make the journey by sea taking Corporal Paskell with him. Without any knowledge of the prevailing tidal streams or currents, and with only a small hand compass to navigate the notorious reef-strewn eastern end of the island, Major Emery and his companion made the dangerous night passage and having collected the Medical Officer began their return journey to Mutayar. By skilful handling, with the assistance of Corporal Paskell who swam alongside the boat to keep it from overturning a successful landing was made. was made.

Without thought for their own safety and at considerable risk to their own lives, Major Emery and Corporal Paskell showed both courage and determina-tion in their successful endeavour to bring medical assistance to a badly injured comrade.
