### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1962

#### *Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way Borough of Chesterfield*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in exercise of his powers under section 155 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over:

1. Part of the footway and carriageway on the east side of Park Road being a part which starts at its junction with Low Pavement and runs south for a distance of approximately 58 yards.

2. The whole of the passageway (known as Froggatt's Yard) between Nos. 75 and 77 Low Pavement, running from its junction with Low Pavement southwards to its junction with Park Road/New Beetwell Street.

3. Part of New Square being that part commencing at a point approximately 20 yards east of its junction with West Bars continuing in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Market Place, then in a southerly direction to its junction with Low Pavement, thence west along Low Pavement for a distance of approximately 52 yards.

4. The southern part of the highway (known as Market Place) immediately to the north of the Market Hall and Market Place being the part which starts at its junction with New Square, and runs east of its junction with High Street.

5. That part of Low Pavement being a part which starts at a point approximately 17 yards east of its junction with West Bars, and runs for a distance of approximately 242 yards.

6. Part of Central Pavement being a part which starts at its junction with the link road east of the Market Place and runs east for a distance of approximately 57 yards.

7. The whole of the link road on the western side of the Market Place.

8. The whole of the link road on the eastern side of the Market Place.

9. Part of The Shambles being that part which starts at its junction with the link road on the eastern side of the Market Place, and runs to a point approximately 3 yards west of its junction with Packers Row.

10. Part of Irongate, being that part which starts at a point approximately 2 yards south of its junction with High Street, and runs south to its junction with Central Pavement.

11. Part of the unnamed passageway between Nos. 7 and 9 High Street being that part which starts at a point approximately 3 yards south of its junction with High Street and runs south to its junction with Central Pavement.

12. Part of the unnamed passageway between Nos. 9 and 11 High Street, being that part which starts at a point approximately 4 yards south of its junction with High Street, and runs south to its junction with Central Pavement.

13. The whole of Wheeldon Lane between its junction with

- (a) Low Pavement and New Beetwell Street.
- (b) New Beetwell Street and Markham Road.
