HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The Catthorpe—Castle Bromwich Motorway (Castle Bromwich Side Roads) Order 196 .

The first part of the above notice which appears in the issue of the 17th August (page 9133) should have read as follows :

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes, in relation to that part of the Catthorpe—Castle Bromwich Motorway which crosses Chester Road (A.452) at Castle Bromwich in the City and County Borough of Birmingham, to make under section 13 of the above Act an Order which will—

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

NEW ZEALAND

The Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that he hereby recognises the Official Certificates of which particulars are given in Part I of the Schedule hereto as showing (a) that the meat to which they relate or the meat from which the meat product to which they relate was prepared, was derived from animals inspected anti and post-mortem and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister, and (b) that all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to public health were taken in the dressing or preparing of the meat or meat product.

Where the Certificate is in the form of a label, recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to the meat or the package containing the meat product and if the label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an Official Certificate; and where the Certificate is in the form of a stamp, recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the meat or the container as the case may be.

Additionally, for each consignment of meat or meat product (including rendered animal fats but excluding canned meat) there will be presented at the time of importation a Veterinary Certificate indicating the details of consignment, place and establishment, number of origin, consignor and consignee, the port of loading and of destination.

With effect from 1st October 1967, the Official Certificate for New Zealand reproduced in Part II of the Schedule and numbered VIII as published in the *London Gazette*, and dated 15th March 1938, together with the notices published in the *London Gazette* and dated 8th September 1944, and 2nd October 1964, in which previously recognised Official Certificates for New Zealand were reproduced in the Schedules thereto, are hereby revoked. The notice published in the *London Gazette* and dated the 14th September 1956, is revoked herewith. The notice published in the *London Gazette* and dated the 24th August 1965, relating to the recognition of the New Zealand Official Certificate is hereby revoked.

The recognition of the Official Certificate is restricted to the extent indicated in Part II of the Schedule hereto.

This consolidated list of establishment numbers replaces those listed in the Schedules to the notices published in the *London Gazette* and dated 22nd March 1966, 8th April 1966, 4th October 1966, and 24th February 1967, which are hereby revoked.
