LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

Lancashire River Authority
Austwick Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has now confirmed the Lancashire River Authority (Abolition of the Austwick Internal Drainage District) Order 1967 (S.I. 1967/1222) made on the 26th June 1967, confirming the Scheme submitted by the Lancashire River Authority under section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930 making provision for the abolition of the Austwick Internal Drainage District and the Drainage Board thereof.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks

after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
