The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act 1958, and section 2 (5) of the Finance Act 1965, viz:

The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 9) Order, 1967.
This Order:

- (i) extends the scope of the existing provisions for the allowance of drawback of import duty on imported materials used in the manufacture of exported chocolate and sugar confectionery, by adding dried egg albumin to the list of imported materials in respect of which drawback may be paid; and
- (ii) provides for the allowance of drawback of import duty on the exportation of:
 - (a) combing oil (a mixture of refined sperm oil, castor oil and fatty acids) manufactured from imported sperm oil and castor oil; and
 - (b) fatty alcohols manufactured from imported sperm oil.

This Order comes into operation on 5th October 1967, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1967 No. 1435.
