MINES AND QUARRIES ACT, 1954

Draft Coal and Other Mines (Shafts, Outlets and Roads) (Amendment) Regulations, 1967

The Minister of Power, in accordance with the provisions of section 142 of, and Part I of the Second Schedule to, the Mines and Quarries Act, 1954, hereby gives notice that he proposes to make General Regulations under sections 141 and 143 of the Act, entitled the Coal and other Mines (Shafts, Outlets and Roads) (Amendment) Regulations, 1967.

These Regulations will apply to mines of coal, stratified ironstone, shale and fireclay and will amend the provisions of the Coal and Other Mines (Shafts, Outlets and Roads) Regulations, 1960, in the following two respects:

- (1) Regulation 18 will be amended so as to require the whole of a shaft, staple-pit or unwalkable outlet through any part of which men are carried to be examined and not merely that part of it through which men are actually carried;
- (2) Regulation 19 (6), which requires cage suspension gear to be annealed or given other appropriate heat treatment, will be amended to enable the Minister to specify the nature of the heat treatment to be given in particular cases or enable such treatment to be dispensed with where this is in the interests of safety.

Any objection to the draft Regulations by, or on behalf of, any person affected thereby must be sent to the Minister of Power, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1, before 25th October 1967. Each such objection must be in writing and must state:

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
