LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

*The City Council of Liverpool (Everton Valley)
(No Waiting) Order 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit with certain exceptions the waiting by vehicles at any time in Everton Valley between its junction with Kirkdale Road and Walton Road and its junction with St. Domingo Road and Kirkdale Vale.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road, or the services therein, to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road and to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle provided that no vehicle (other than a vehicle being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets, as defined in section 87 of the Post Offices Act, 1953), shall so wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday in each week.

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Northampton (Park Street, Towcester)
(Weight Restriction) Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any motor vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds three tons to proceed in

the road specified in the Schedule to this notice. Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable vehicles to proceed in the road in question if the vehicle is being used:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to and from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road;
- (b) for purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to that road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber upon that land; or
- (c) in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.

POOLE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Poole (Sopers Lane Area) (Prohibition of Waiting)
Order, 1967*

(c) *Access road leading to Corporation's Sewage Works* (both sides) from its junction with Sopers Lane to a point 45 feet in a southerly direction.

(d) *Wavell Avenue* (both sides) from its junction with Sopers Lane to a point 45 feet north of its junction with Plumer Road.

(e) *Plumer Road* (both sides) from its junction with Wavell Avenue to a point 45 feet in an easterly direction.

(f) *Rugby Road* (both sides) from its junction with Sopers Lane to a point 45 feet in a northerly direction.
