The County of Devon (Saxe Street Bridge, Teignmouth) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Devon Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle the weight of which, whether

laden or unladen, exceeds seven tons from proceeding in that length of Saxe Street, Teignmouth, which is carried by the Saxe Street Bridge.

Public service vehicles with a gross weight, whether laden or unladen, not exceeding ten and a half tons will be exempt from the provisions of the Order.
