*The Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads, Filton) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Variation) Order, 1967.*

#### GLoucestershire County Council

*The Gloucestershire County Council (Roads in Parishes of Alveston, Aust and Olveston) (Restriction) Order, 1967.*

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucestershire County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any motor vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto. Alternative routes for such vehicles are available.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit the driving on any of the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent thereto; (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to such roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land; (c) refuse collection by the Thornbury R.D.C.; (d) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to such roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, etc., of such roads or the services therein. The exceptions will also apply to any public service vehicle while being used as a stage carriage on the length of road specified in items 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto.

Copies of the Order and relevant Plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at (a) the Shire Hall (Room 213), Gloucester, and (b) the offices of the Thornbury Rural District Council, Council Offices, Thornbury, during 21 days from the date of this notice.

5. That length of the Olveston-Elberton road (3/238), in the Parish of Olveston, which extends from its junction with the Almondsbury-Aust road (B.4461) in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Redhill Lane (3/238).

6. That length of Foxholes Lane (unclassified) in the Parish of Olveston, which extends from its junction with the Olveston-Alveston road (B.4461) (Spur) in a northerly direction to its junction with Vattingsstone Lane (3/238).
