

SWANSEA COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Swansea (Llangyfelach Road-Eaton Road) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Swansea County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of streets listed in the Schedule hereto.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 10th day of November 1967.

THE SCHEDULE

(a) *Llangyfelach Road*, west side from the kerb line in front of the Commercial Inn, Pentre Estyll, to a point 115 yards north of that line, and from the line of the southern kerb of Robert Street to a point 40 yards south of that line.

(b) *Llangyfelach Road*, east side from a point opposite the kerb line fronting the Commercial Inn to a point 100 yards north of that line and to a point 40 yards south of that line.

(c) *Eaton Road*, east side from the line of the kerb fronting the Commercial Inn to a point 70 yards north of that line.

(d) At the junction of Eaton Road and Llangyfelach Road from the line of kerb of Eaton Road east side to the line of kerb of Llangyfelach Road west side.

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of East Sussex (Dyke Road, Poynings) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearway) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the main carriageway of Dyke Road, Poynings, from its junction with Saddlescombe Road, C.56a, to the entrance to the forecourt of the Dyke Hotel, a distance of approximately 700 yards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or for so long as may be necessary in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or of any structure, works or apparatus in, on, under or over it. The exceptions will also enable vehicles to wait on the main carriageway when being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, the delivery or collection of postal packets, the collection of household refuse, the clearing of cesspools, or whilst any gate or barrier at the entrance to premises to which a vehicle requires access is being opened or closed.

A copy of the proposed Order and of the map showing the length of road affected may be inspected at my office during normal office hours.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The Administrative County of West Sussex (Westbourne: The Square) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times on both sides of the northern arm of The Square, Westbourne, joining North Street and East Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise; to wait when engaged in building operations, or the repairs of the road or the services therein, or to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage, and in connection with funerals.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The Administrative County of West Sussex (Pulborough: Cray Lane Bridge, Codmore Hill) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 8 tons, from proceeding in that length of Cray Lane, Codmore Hill, which is carried by the Cray Lane Bridge.

Public service vehicles with a gross weight, whether laden or unladen, not exceeding 10½ tons will be exempt from the provisions of the Order.

An alternative route for westbound vehicles affected by the proposed Order will be: proceed northwestwards along Broomershill Lane to Road A.29, turn left and proceed southwestwards to junction with Cray Lane; and vice versa for eastbound vehicles.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the length of road affected by the Order and the alternative route may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours until 30th October 1967.

Objections to the Order must be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport (UT), at St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, by 30th October 1967, and a copy sent to the undersigned.
