YORK CITY COUNCIL

The City of York (Fawcett Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967 -

Notice is hereby given that the York City Council on the 2nd October 1967, made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of a vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The provisions of the Order will not apply so as to prevent a vehicle waiting for so long as may be necessary:

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, wedding, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.

A copy of the Order together with a map indicating the length of road affected is available for inspection at the office of the undersigned. The Order will come into operation on the 1st November 1967.

EAST SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

(ii) Park Road, from a point at its junction with Stowmarket Road to a point 250 feet south of its junction with Stowmarket Road.

(iii) Stowmarket Road, from a point 250 feet south-east of its junction with Church Street to a point 250 feet north-west of its junction with Church Street.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1962

City of Leicester Development Plan

Notice is hereby given that proposals for alterations or additions to the above Development Plan were on the 9th October 1967, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposals comprise the definition as a Comprehensive Development Area and the designation for compulsory acquisition of certain lands, and relate to land in the Grasmere Street/Joseph Street area situate in the City of Leicester.

A certified copy of the proposals as submitted has been deposited for public inspection at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Leicester.

The copy of the proposals so deposited together with copies or relevant extracts of the Development Plan are available for inspection, free of charge, by all persons interested at the place mentioned above, between 9 a.m. and 12 noon and 2.30 p.m. and 5 p.m. on any weekday except Saturdays.

Persons making an objection or representation may register their names and addresses with the Leicester City Council and will then be entitled to receive notice of any amendment of the Development Plan made as a result of the proposals.
