of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1968 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local

Government.

Copies of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Failsworth, near Manchester, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 18th day of October 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

The City of Hereford (College Road) (Weight Restriction) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Hereford City Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit:

(a) any motor vehicle or trailer, being a track laying vehicle, or

from proceeding in that length of College Road which is carried by the bridge over the Hereford-Shrewsbury railway line.
