- (i) South side, from Bolton Road for 50 yards in a westerly direction; (ii) South side, from 77 yards west of Bolton Road to 40 yards east of Cornfield Road; (iii) South side, from 120 ft. east of Gildredge Road to 192 ft. west of Cornfield Road; field Road.
- 5. To limit the unilateral waiting of vehicles in the following roads to one hour on all days:

Terminus Road

- (i) South side, from 261 ft. east of Bolton Road to 160 ft. north-east of Trinity Trees; (ii) North side, from Langney Road to 40 yards north-west of Seaside Road.
- 6. To limit the unilateral waiting of vehicles in the following roads to one hour on all days between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.:

Cavendish Place

(i) East side, from 187 ft. north-west of Langney Road to 75 ft. south-east of Ashford Road; (ii) West side, from 144 ft. north-west of Langney Road to 75 ft. south-east of Ashford
