Notice is hereby given that on the 16th day of October 1967, the Urban District Council of Bromsgrove made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit with certain usual exceptions the waiting of vehicles in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order will come into effect on the 6th day of December 1967.

Callowbridge Road. Between its junction with New Road and a point 200 feet north of that junction.

New Road

(a) The south side:—between the west side of its junction with Legion Road and a point 30 feet east of its junction with Beverley Road.

(b) The north side:

(i) from a point opposite the west side of Legion Road for a distance of 210 feet measured in an easterly direction;

(ii) from a point 160 feet west of Callowbridge Road for a distance of 380 feet measured in an easterly direction.

The County Borough of Burton upon Trent (Town  
Centre) Waiting Restrictions Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Burton upon Trent propose to make an Order under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 26 and subsection (4) of section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other powers them enabling the effect of which will be to restrict the parking of vehicles in the undermentioned parts of streets as follows:

Waiting restricted on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

High Street. From its junction with the Market Place (Ellis & Son (Burton) Limited) to its junction with New Street a distance of 85 yards.

Lichfield Street from the west boundary of Number 10 to its junction with Fleet Street and Park Street a distance of 126 yards.

Fleet Street from its junction with Abbey Street (west side) to its junction with Stapenhill Viaduct a distance of 133 yards.
