### WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

#### *Rubber Proofed Garment Making Industry Wages Council*

The Rubber Proofed Garment Making Industry Wages Council hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Rubber Proofed

Garment) Order 1967 (Order R.P.G.(22)); (2) amending the provisions relating to customary holidays set out in the Wages Regulation (Rubber Proofed Garment) (Holidays) Order 1967 (Order R.P.G.(23)); and (3) the revocation of Order R.P.G.(22).

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 27th October 1967. The Minister of Transport in exercise of her powers under the Light Railways Act 1896, as amended by the Light Railways Act 1912 and by Part V of the Railways Act 1921 made the British Railways Board (Keighley and Worth Valley) Light Railway Order 1967 (S.I. 1967, No. 1529) on 16th October 1967. ### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1960

#### *Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit—Tolpuddle, Dorset*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport intends to make an Order, under the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice shall become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.

Any objection to the making of the Order should be sent to the Divisional Road Engineer, Ministry of Transport, Government Buildings, Alington Road, Exeter, not later than 17th November 1967, quoting the reference number DSW 30028/1/T/01.

### SCHEDULE

That length of the Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road (Route No. A.35) at Tolpuddle in the County of Dorset which extends from a point 190 yards east of its junction with White Hill in an eastward direction for a distance, measured along the said road, of approximately 478 yards.

#### *The Trunk Road (High Street, Marlborough, Wilts) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1967*

The Minister of Transport has made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 the effect of which is:

(a) to impose waiting restrictions between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. seven days a week on the sides of the London-Bristol Trunk Road (A.4) known as High Street, in the Borough of Marlborough specified in Schedule 1 hereto;

(b) to impose limited waiting restrictions for 30 minutes in any hour between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. seven days a week on the sides of the said trunk road specified in Schedule 2 hereto.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
