HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Borough of Hertford Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 Section 9

The Hertfordshire County Council (Maidenhead Street, Hertford) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) (Experimental) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the Hertfordshire County Council made the above Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, and it came into force on 24th August 1967. Its effect is to prohibit through traffic in Maidenhead Street, Hertford, between its junction with The Wash and Bull Plain. An exemption in the Order permits access to property in Maidenhead Street, which remains as a one-way street.

The Order was made for the maximum period of three months, but in order to permit the closer study of traffic flow in the Town Centre, following the opening of the Hertford Relief Road, The County Council proposes to apply to the Minister of Transport for an extension of the Order for a further period of fifteen months until 24th February 1969.
