#### PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

*The Portsmouth (Copnor Road/Milton Road) (Restrictions on Waiting and Loading and Unloading) (No. 7) Order, 1967.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th October 1967, the Portsmouth City Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is as follows:

##### A. Prohibition of Waiting at All Times

To prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road:

- St. Swithun's Road.* The south side between a point 84 feet west of its junction with the west side of Copnor Road and a point 104 feet west of that junction.
- Allcot Road.* The north side between a point 85 feet east of its junction with the east side of Copnor Road and a point 120 feet east of that junction.
- Powerscourt Road.* The north side between a point 130 feet west of its junction with the west side of Copnor Road and a point 160 feet west of that junction.
- Kensington Road.* Between a point 30 feet south of its junction with Mayfield Road and a point 30 feet north of that junction.
- Mayfield Road.*
  - The south side between a point 30 feet east of its junction with Kensington Road and a point 30 feet west of that junction.
  - The north side between its junction with the west side of Kensington Road and a point 30 feet west of that junction.
  - The north side between a point 150 feet west of its junction with Copnor Road and its junction with Kensington Road.
- Burrfields Road.* The south side between its junction with the west side of Highgate Road and a point 30 feet west of that junction.
- Highgate Road.* The west side between its junction with Burrfields Road and a point 30 feet south of that junction.
- Coniston Avenue.* The north side between its junction with the east side of Copnor Road and a point 15 feet east of that junction.
- Tangier Road.* The south side between its junction with Milton Road and a point 20 feet west of that junction.
- Dudley Road.* The north side between its junction with the west side of Milton Road and a point 36 feet west of that junction.
- Milton Road.* The east side between a point opposite a point 25 feet south of the south side of Dudley Road and a point opposite a point 215 feet south of the south side of Dudley Road.
- Kimbolton Road*

##### 12. Kimbolton Road

- The west side between its junction with Langstone Road and a point 15 feet north of that junction.
- The east side between its junction with Langstone Road and a point 95 feet north of that junction.

##### B. Waiting Restricted to One Hour on Weekdays (8 a.m.—6 p.m.)

To restrict waiting to a maximum of one hour in any two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays on the following lengths of road:

- Coniston Avenue.* The north side between a point 15 feet east of its junction with the

east side of Copnor Road and a point 65 feet east of that junction.

- Tangier Road.* The south side between a point 20 feet west of the west side of Milton Road and a point 50 feet west of the west side of Milton Road.
- Kimbolton Road.* The west side between a point 15 feet north of its junction with Langstone Road and a point 87 feet north of that junction.
- Milton Park Avenue.* The north side between a point 26 feet east of its junction with the east side of Milton Road and a point 90 feet east of that junction.
- Posbrooke Road.* The south side between a point 26 feet east of its junction with the east side of Milton Road and a point 96 feet east of that junction.

- Milton Road.* The east side between a point 20 feet south of its junction with Posbrooke Road and a point 100 feet south of that junction.

##### C. Prohibition of Loading and Unloading between certain Hours on Weekdays

To prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on the following lengths of road:

- Tangier Road.* The south side between its junction with Milton Road and a point 20 feet west of that junction.
  - Milton Road.* The east side between a point opposite a point 25 feet south of the south side of Dudley Road and a point opposite a point 215 feet south of the south side of Dudley Road.
- Exceptions are provided in this Order to allow a vehicle to wait to enable:
- a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or work on or under the lengths of road;
  - the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage on or adjacent to the lengths of road;
  - postal packets to be collected or delivered;
  - furniture removers to remove furniture from the lengths of road in part C of this Order at times when the loading and unloading of goods would otherwise be prohibited provided they give 24 hours notice to the police, obtain their consent and comply with any reasonable police requirements.

An exception is also provided to enable vehicles used by registered Medical Practitioners to wait while they are engaged upon their professional duties.

#### PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

*The Portsmouth (Various Roads) (Restrictions on Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th October 1967, the Portsmouth City Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is as follows:

##### A. Prohibition of Waiting

To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road:

##### 1. Park Road

- North side—between a point 140 feet east of the east side of Anglesea Road and a point 156 feet west of the west side of Anglesea Road.
- South side—between a point 290 feet east of the east side of St. Michael's Road and a point 150 feet west of the west side of St. Michael's Road.

- St. Michael's Road.* West side—between its junction with the south side of Park Road and a point 191 feet south of that junction.
