

ST. HELENS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of St. Helens (Various Streets) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that the St. Helens County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 the effect of which is:

- (1) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day except Sunday in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (2) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles for a longer period than two hours in any four between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day except Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this notice on the side and length of road specified opposite that road in the second column of the said Second Schedule;
- (3) to impose alternating unilateral waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. with waiting limited to two hours in any four on the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice. Waiting will be prohibited on the sides of each road specified in the second column of the said Schedule on Monday, Wednesday and Friday in every week and on the side of each road specified in the third column of the said Schedule on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday in every week;
- (4) the time limit referred to in Clauses (2) and (3) of this notice will be waived for disabled drivers whose vehicles display in conspicuous positions yellow badges issued by any local authority in pursuance of a scheme under section 29 of the National Assistance Act, 1948.

The Order contains the usual exemptions for boarding and alighting from vehicles, loading or unloading goods, building operations, road maintenance, etc., funeral vehicles (and for enabling vehicles to take in petrol etc. from a garage).

The Order will revoke existing Traffic Regulation Orders in so far as they vary or are inconsistent with the Order.

A copy of the proposed Order and map showing the lengths of road affected may be seen at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, St. Helens during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 10th November 1967.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(No Waiting)

Lengths of road in the County Borough of St. Helens

1. Birchley Street	East side—whole length. West side: (A) From Corporation Street to Tolver Street (north side), and (B) From Clifton Street (south side) to Standish Street.
2. Brynn Street	Both sides: (A) From Parade Street to 60 feet north of Tolver Street, and (B) From 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
3. Hardshaw Street (North)	Both sides: (A) From Corporation Street to 60 feet north of Tolver Street, and (B) From 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
4. Vincent Street	Both sides: (A) From Corporation Street to Parade Street, and (B) From 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
5. Charles Street	Both sides from Corporation Street to Parade Street. East side from Cansfield Street to Standish Street. West side: (A) From Cansfield Street to 60 feet north of Cansfield Street, (B) From 60 feet south of Clifton Street to 60 feet north of Clifton Street, and (C) From 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
6. Alfred Street	Both sides: (A) From Cansfield Street to 180 feet north of Cansfield Street, (B) From 20 feet south of Clifton Street to 20 feet north of Clifton Street, and (C) From 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
7. Woodville Street (Tolver Street to Cansfield Street) (Clifton Street to Standish Street)				East side. Both sides from 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
8. Hall Street (Corporation Street to Shaw Street) (Shaw Street to Standish Street)				Both sides—full length. West side—full length. East side from 240 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
9. Shaw Street (Corporation Street to Hall Street)				West side—full length. East side from Corporation Street to 60 feet north of Corporation Street. Both sides from 60 feet south of Standish Street to Standish Street.
10. Parade Street	Both sides—Town Hall Yard to Charles Street.
11. Tolver Street	Both sides from Birchley Street to east side of Charles Street. North side from Hospital entrance to Hall Street. South side from Charles Street to Hall Street.
12. Cansfield Street	Both sides from Birchley Street to Alfred Street. South side from Alfred Street to Shaw Street. North side from passage at rear of 30 Woodville Street to Shaw Street.
13. Clifton Street	Both sides from Birchley Street to Shaw Street.
14. Central Street (from College Street to railway) (Lincoln House to Standish Street)	Both sides from College Street to Railway fence. West side—full length. East side: (A) From Lincoln House to 60 feet north of same, and (B) 60 feet south of Dicconson Street to Standish Street.
15. Garswood Street	Both sides from College Street to Central Street.
16. Dicconson Street	Both sides from College Street to Central Street.
17. Ward Street	Both sides: (A) From College Street to 100 feet west of College Street, and (B) From 100 feet east of North Road to North Road.
18. Crab Street (From College Street to North Road) (From North Road to end of Church property). (From end of Church property to Duke Street).				Both sides. North side from North Road to end of Church property. South side from North Road to 60 feet west of North Road. Both sides.
