## EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

# The Borough of Eastleigh (Various Streets) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Eastleigh Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles:

- (a) in the lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule hereto;
- (b) in excess of 30 minutes in any one hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (c) in excess of 60 minutes in any two hours in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto.

2. To revoke the Borough of Eastleigh (Leigh Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1960 and the Borough of Eastleigh (Southampton Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1964.

3. To prohibit any person from driving any vehicle or causing or permitting any vehicle to be driven on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Fourth Schedule hereto otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length in the second column of the Fourth Schedule.

4. To prohibit any person from causing or per-mitting any vehicle to be driven in an easterly direc-tion on the road specified in the first column of the Fifth Schedule hereto so as to make a right turn into the road specified in the second column of the Fifth Schedule.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow vehicles to wait as long as may be necessary to enable persons to board or alight and goods to be loaded or unloaded, and to enable vehicles to be used in confunction with building operations, public works and funcrals and to enable vehicles to wait as long as may be necessary in the length of road numbered 8 in the First Schedule hereto when the vehicles are being used in connection with a marriage or funeral at a place of religious worship.

A copy of the Draft Order and a plan showing the lengths of roads affected are available for inspection during usual office hours at my office.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 29th November 1967.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Borough of Eastleigh

1. Leigh Road-south side-from its junction with Southampton Road for a distance of 139 feet in a westerly direction.

2. Leigh Road—north side—from its junction with Southampton Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Market Street.

3. Market Street-cast side-from its junction with Leigh Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Romsey Road.

4. Market Street—west side—from a point 156 feet north of its junction with Leigh Road for a distance of 150 feet in a northerly direction.

5. Market Street—west side—from its junction with Romsey Road for a distance of 75 feet in a southerly direction.

6. Romsey Road—south side—from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 120 feet in a westerly direction.

7. Romsey Road—south side—from its junction with Southampton Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Market Street.

8. Romsey Road—north side—from its junction with Southampton Road for a distance of 400 feet in a westerly direction.

9. Southampton Road-west side-from its junc-tion with Leigh Road for a distance of 105 feet in a northerly direction.

10. Southampton Road-west side-from the boundary between The Crown Hotel and No. 24 South-ampton Road for a distance of 25 feet in a northerly direction.

11. Southampton Road-west side-from the boundary between Nos. 18 and 20 Southampton Road for a distance of 62 feet in a northerly direction.

12. Southampton Road-west side-from its junction with Romsey Road for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

### SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Borough of Eastleigh

1. Southampton Road—west side—from a point 45 feet south of its junction with Romsey Road for a distance of 195 feet in a southerly direction.

#### **GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL**

The Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street, Pontardawe) (Revocation and Prohibition of Wait-ing) Order, 1967.

Notice is hereby given that the Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be:

- (a) To revoke the provisions contained in "The Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street, Pontardawe) (Limitation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967;
- (b) to prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles for 24 hours per day, seven days per week on the northern side of Herbert Street, Pontardawe, from its junction with High Street to its junction with Holly Street, Pontardawe, and also on the southern side of Herbert Street, Pontardawe, from its junction with High Street to a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 45-47 Herbert Street;
- (c) to limit the waiting of vehicles to 20 minutes in any hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the northern side of Herbert Street, Pontardawe, from the junction with Holly Street to the level crossing
- (d) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the whole of the southern side of Herbert Street, Pontardawe, with the exception of the two lay-bys therein, from a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 45-47 Herbert Street to the level crossing;
- (e) to limit the waiting of vehicles to 20 minutes in any hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, in the lay-bys on the southern side of Herbert Street, Pontardawe.
