HUDDERSFIELD COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Huddersfield (Part of Wakefield Road) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Huddersfield County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to:

Prevent persons except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait on any weekday in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto and to prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles on the said lengths of road between the hours of 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any weekday.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary—

- (1) for a person to board or alight from the vehicle or
- (2) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road or the services therein or
- (3) to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or
- (4) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle at times otherwise than between 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any weekday.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the twenty-seventh day of November 1967.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the Isle of Wight (The Broadway, Totland) (No Waiting) Order No. 1, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight County Council have made an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to:

- (a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles subject to the usual exemptions in the following lengths of road:—

- (b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays subject to the usual exemptions in the following length of road:—

The Broadway from a point 50 ft. north of its junction with The Mall to its junction with Weston Road	East

The Order will come into operation on Friday, the 27th October 1967.
