PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

CHESTERFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Chesterfield No. 5 (Dunston) Smoke Control Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Chesterfield in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 3rd day of October 1967, made an Order entitled *The Chesterfield No. 5 (Dunston) Smoke Control Order 1967*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

It is confirmed that the Order will not come into operation before the expiration of the period of twelve months from the date of confirmation of the Order by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, or before such later date as the Minister of Housing and Local Government shall determine.

The Order provides that the fireplaces in buildings or parts of buildings separately occupied without gas supply shall be exempted from the provisions of the said section 11 on condition that only authorised fuels are declared by regulations under the Clean Air Act 1956 and kindling sticks and paper shall be used in the fireplaces.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Chesterfield, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 10th day of November 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That continuous area of land bounded on the north side by the centre line of Dunston Road from the junction with Dunston Lane to the junction with Racecourse Road, on the west side by the centre line of Dunston Lane from the junction with Littlemoor to the junction with Dunston Road and on the south and east sides by the centre line of Littlemoor and St. John's Road from the junction with Dunston Lane extending eastward to Racecourse Road, and thence by the centre line of Racecourse Road extending north-east to the junction with Dunston Road.
