In the lengths of road specified in schedules 2 and 3 exceptions will be provided to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, for the delivery or collection of postal packets or to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, provided that a vehicle shall not wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2:

- (i) for any of these purposes between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m.
- (ii) for the purpose of loading or unloading goods between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. for a longer period than 20 minutes outside the same premises.
