

The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Fosdyke and Kirton in the Rural District of Boston in the County of Lincoln, Parts of Holland and the Parishes of Billingsborough, Haconby, Morton and Poinon and Sempringham in the Rural District of South Kesteven in the County of Lincoln, Parts of Kesteven.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless during the period ending with 4th December 1967 a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965, S.I. 1965/443) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Scheme and of the map referred to therein, has been deposited at the offices of the South Kesteven Rural District Council, 41 North Street, Bourne, at the offices of the Lincolnshire River Authority, 50 Wide Bargate, Boston, and at the Offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 410, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, for public inspection during normal office hours within the period ending with 4th December 1967.
