

2. The Borough of Epsom and Ewell (Prohibition of Waiting) (Stoneleigh) Order, 1967.

The effect of this Order is to:

Prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. and the loading and unloading of vehicles between the hours of 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. for more than twenty minutes outside the same premises on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule hereto. The usual exemptions to permit the waiting of vehicles for certain specified purposes will apply. The Orders will come into operation on the 20th November 1967.

Rosedale Road, from The Broadway to the division boundary of Nos. 56-58; Gayfere Road, from The Broadway to the boundary of Nos. 62-64; Woodstone Avenue, from the junction of The Broadway and The Glade to a point 20 feet north of the division boundary of Nos. 61-63; Bradstock Road, from The Glade to a point 17 feet south of the division boundary of Nos. 27-29; The Glade, from the junction with Dell Road and Woodstone Avenue to the division boundary of Nos. 29-31; Kenilworth Road; Briarwood Road, from the junction of Briarwood Close and Kenilworth Road to a point 20 feet south-east of the division boundary of Nos. 54-56; Dell Road; Clandon Close, from the junction of Briarwood Road and Kenilworth Road to a point 19 feet north-east of the division boundary of Nos. 39-40; Claverley Road, from Clandon Close to a point 10 feet south-east of the division boundary of Nos. 10-12; and Glenwood Road, Stoneleigh from Briarwood Road to the division boundary of Nos. 19-21; Stoneleigh Park Road, from Kingston Road to the division boundary of Nos. 125-127; Seaforth Gardens, from Stoneleigh Park Road to a point 20 feet north of the division boundary of Nos. 67-69; and Newbury Gardens, Ewell, from Stoneleigh Park Road to a point 7 feet north of the division boundary of Nos. 46-48.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads, Winchcombe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that on the 30th October 1967, the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (other than an invalid carriage) at all times in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order, which will revoke and re-enact certain waiting restrictions, will not prohibit a vehicle from waiting in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as is necessary (a) to enable a person to board or alight or to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The Order will come into operation on the 13th November 1967.

SCHEDULE

(a) *Hailes Street (A.46)*, between its junction with Chandos Street and Silk Mill Lane and its junction with High Street (A.46) and Vick Lane (sometimes known as Bick Lane).

(b) *High Street (A.46)*, between its junction with Hailes Street (A.46) and Vick Lane (sometimes known as Bick Lane) and its junction with Abbey Terrace (A.46).

(c) *North Street (B.4078)*, between its junction with High Street (A.46) and a point 100 yards north-west of that junction.

(d) *Gloucester Street (A.46)*, the north-west side thereof, between a point 15 yards, north-east of its junction with Malthouse Lane and a point 15 yards south-west of that junction.

(e) *Malthouse Lane (Class III)*, between its junction with Gloucester Street (A.46) and a point 65 yards north-west of that junction.
