7. revoke the provisions of the Leicester (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1960, in so far as it applies to the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto and all the provisions of the Leicester (Groby Road, Fosse Road North and Blackbird Road) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1964.
