*Shaftesbury Rural District Council Public Path (part of Bridleways Nos. 19 and 16 Iwerne Minster/Sutton Waldron) Diversion Order, 1967.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th day of October 1967, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect is:

##### A

As from the 7th November 1967, to extinguish a public right of way of undefined width which begins at the point marked "A" on the map at the north-westerly corner of Ordnance Survey parcel No. 7 at the Lodge gates and runs north-easterly and northerly for approximately 390 yards to the point "B" on the boundary with the parishes of Iwerne Minster and Sutton Waldron and then continues northerly for a further distance of 270 yards to the point "C" on the map at the south-west corner of Sutton Hill Plantation, and substitute:

A bridleway 8 feet wide and approximately 720 yards long and beginning at the above-mentioned point "A" and running northerly to a point "D" indicated on the above-mentioned parish boundary and adjacent to the west boundary of Ordnance Survey parcel No. 9 and then continuing in a northerly and easterly direction, crossing the lane from Sutton Hill Farm at a stile and continuing to the above-mentioned point "C" on the map.
