ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

EPSOM AND EWELL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Epsom and Ewell (Prohibition of Waiting) (Stoneleigh) (Amendment) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Epsom and Ewell Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to amend the Borough of Epsom and Ewell (Prohibition of Waiting) (Stoneleigh) Order 1967, as though there was added to the Schedule of that Order the following lengths of road:

Rosedale Road, Stoneleigh, from the division boundary of 56-58 Rosedale Road to the boundary of Nos. 85 and 87 Rosedale Road.

Briarwood Road, Stoneleigh, from a point 20 feet south-east of the division boundary of 54-56 Briarwood Road to London Road.

Calverley Road from a point 10 feet south-east of the division boundary of Nos. 10-12 to the junction with Glenwood Road.

Glenwood Road, Stoneleigh, from the division boundary of Nos. 19-21 to the roundabout at the junction of Calverley Road and Park Avenue East.

The Order will prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. and the loading and unloading of vehicles between the hours of 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. for more than 20 minutes outside the same premises from Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the said lengths of road.
