

8. The south side of that length of the trunk road, known as High Street, which extends:

- (a) from its junction with Yorke Street to a point 40 feet west of that junction; and
- (b) from a point 170 feet west of its junction with Yorke Street to its junction with Church Street.

9. The south side of that length of the trunk road, known as Town Hill, which extends:

- (a) from its junction with Church Street to a point 66 feet west of that junction; and
- (b) from a point 96 feet west of its junction with Church Street to its junction with Abbot Street.

10. The south-east side of that length of the trunk road, known as Pen-y-Bryn, which extends from a point 127 feet north-east of its junction with Teters Square to a point 80 feet north-east of its junction with Ruthin Road.

1. The west side of that length of the trunk road, known as Chester Road, which extends from a point 148 yards south of its junction with Grove Park to its junction with Park Avenue.

2. The west side of that length of the trunk road, known as Chester Street, which extends:

- (a) from a point 40 feet south of its junction with Llwyn Isaf to a point 170 feet north of its junction with Lambpit Street; and
- (b) from a point 130 feet south of its junction with Lambpit Street to a point 102 feet north of its junction with Henblas Street.

3. The north side of that length of the trunk road, known as High Street, which extends from a point 155 feet east of its junction with Hope Street to a point 35 feet east of that junction.

4. The north side of that length of the trunk road, known as Town Hill, which extends from a point 21 feet west of its junction with Hope Street to a point 21 feet east of its junction with Abbot Street.

5. The north-west side of that length of the trunk road, known as Pen-y-Bryn, which extends:

- (a) from a point 127 feet north-east of its junction with Teters Square to a point 25 feet north-east of that junction; and
