- (i) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident; or
- (j) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Postmaster General and waiting in any affected length of road while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to that length of road are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to that length of road, or is in use in connection with the cleaning of telephone kiosks adjacent to that length of road.
- 7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, or by or under any other enactment.
- 8. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
